Afterwards, head to the Caldeiras, situated next to the famous Furnas Lake, to watch a cooking demonstration where you'll learn how to cook using the natural heat of the caldeiras. Tuck into traditional <i>cozido</i> for lunch at a local restaurant before exploring more of the sights of the Furnas Valley as you learn about everyday life in this volcanic environment. On the way back to Ponta Delgada, stop at the Pico do Ferro Viewpoint for unforgettable views of this unique landscape. Overnight stay in Ponta Delgada.</p>

Begin with a tour of a pineapple plantation to observe the fascinating growing phases of this delicious tropical fruit and to taste a local pineapple liqueur. Continue to the stunning Pico do Carvao, which boasts brilliant views across the central part of Sao Miguel island. At Vista do Rei viewpoint you can enjoy the incredible landscapes across Sete Cidades. Descend into the crater to admire Lagoa de Santiago before returning to Ponta Delgada. Enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure to continue exploring the island. Maybe head down to one of the many lively cafes in the center along the charming cobblestone streets. Overnight stay in Ponta Delgada.



June 19

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, enjoy a day at your leisure. Take some time to relax after several jam-packed days of sightseeing, or try going for a hike on this mountainous island. Alternatively, we recommend an optional whale and dolphin watching excursion*. Overnight stay in Ponta Delgada.

*Optional whale and dolphin watching excursion: Enjoy a fun 3-hour boat trip to observe the exciting marine life of the Azores. The huge sperm whales, sei whales and fin whales are the most common in the area, as are the graceful bottlenose dolphins.

Note: please be aware that dolphin and whale sightings are not always guaranteed.



June 20

Breakfast at the hotel. Take today at your leisure to explore the delights of the island. Get to know the local culture, enjoy the unique climate of this Atlantic archipelago and take some time for sightseeing. Overnight stay in Ponta Delgada.

**June 21**

Breakfast at the hotel. Today is your last day on the islands so make the most of it! Enjoy today at your leisure to continue discovering what this enchanting island has to offer. Why not take advantage of the many walking paths to explore the untouched natural landscapes or pay a visit to the tranquil António Borges Botanical Gardens? You can head downtown to the shopping area to pick up some souvenirs, and have a bite to eat in one of the many restaurants available. Overnight stay in Ponta Delgada.
